Resolution 4 (2014)

Adopted by the Secutrity Council at its 1st meeting, on 14 November 2014

The Security Council,

Guided by the purposes, principles and provisions of the Charter of the United Nations,

Recalling Security Council resolutions 822 (1993) of 30 April 1993, 853 (1993) of 29 July 1993, 874 (1993) of 14 October 1993 and 884 (1993) of 12 November 1993, as well as its resolutions 48/114 of 20 December 1993, entitled "Emergency international assistance to refugees and displaced persons in Azerbaijan", and 60/285 of 7 September 2006, entitled "The situation in the occupied territories of Azerbaijan",

Reaffirming the commitments of the parties to the conflict to abide scrupulously by the rules of international humanitarian law,

Seriously concerned that the armed conflict in and around the Nagorno-Karabakh region of the Republic of Azerbaijan continues to endanger international peace and security, and mindful of its adverse implications for the humanitarian situation and development of the countries of the South Caucasus,

Calls to undertake additional efforts and confidence-building measures to reinforce the ceasefire and strengthen the peace process, due to difficulties caused by long-termed and substantial contradiction between Armenia and Azerbaijan,

Takes the opportunity to advise the UN special envoy, Secretary General or goodwill ambassador the use of its "good offices" which would help to find a political, equitable and lasting settlement to the Nagorno-Karabakh crisis,

Uses the opportunity to reiterate its complete confidence that the resolution of the Nagorno-Karabakh conflict is possible exclusively by negotiations and suggests creating the discussion platform to provide the possibility for the Armenian and Azerbaijani authorities to hold the monthly meetings aiming to resolve the situation with the following reporting to the SC,

Proposes the CIS to enforce all its diplomatic mechanisms and influence to promote the resolution of the problem and act as a platform for discussion,

Urges to create Special Cultural Committee to reconcile Azerbaijan and Armenia nationals and proposes international non-governmental organizations to develop holding of different cultural conferences with Armenian and Azerbaijan participants.
