Resolution 1 (2015)

Adopted by the Security Council at its 1 meeting, on 9 April 2013

The Security Council,

Reaffirming its full respect for the sovereignty, independence and territorial integrity of Ukraine,

Acting under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations,

Fully aware that the situation in Ukraine mustn't be escalated,

Deeply concerned at the tragic events and violence in eastern regions of Ukraine,

Having considered its Resolutions 2166 (2014), 2202 (2015),

- 1. Calls upon all member-states to give guaranties of non-participation of their military formations in Ukrainian conflict,
- 2. Suggests creating a comprehensive programme of humanitarian aid to Ukraine organized and controlled by United Nations competent bodies,
- 3. *Recommends* inviting Belarus as a mediator in a peaceful solution of the Ukrainian conflict and to provide Belarus with all necessary assistance,

Decides to remain actively seized of the matter.
