## Resolution adopted by the Economic and Social Council on 1 April 2016

Economic and Social Council,

*Taking into consideration* that nowadays we have the largest generation of young people the world has ever known,

Aware of the problem that the great number of them live in countries that have faced a violent conflict and millions of them are unemployed,

*Believing* that the voice of the world's youth speaks clearly on the future they want,

*Noting that* the views of the young generation must count,

- 1. Invites developed countries to invest in students' educational exchange programs between developed and developing countries;
- 2. Encourages government agencies to provide programs centered on youth empowerment through creating steering committees for youth or to provide places in existing local and national bodies with places for young representatives;
- 3. Suggests to implement basic fixed income program in order to advocate youth's financial security;
- 4. Encourages to introduce active youth employment policy for implementing technical training in the framework of specialized secondary and higher education to match the link between education system, vocational methods and the need of the labour market;
- 5. Strongly urges governments to encourage employers to provide workplace for young people by introduction of incentives for such enterprises through:
  - a) tax decrease;
  - b) grants provided by means of tenders;
  - c) rent cost indulgence:
- 6. *Invites* to introduce sex education classes in high school for teenagers and provide consulting assistance for parents on how to correctly

convey the information connected with sex education to children in order to prevent spreading HIV/AIDS and other sexually-transmitted diseases and teenage pregnancy.
