Resolution adopted by the Economic and Social Council on 31 March 2017

Economic and Social Council.

Taking into account the main subjects of the 1951 Convention Relating to the Status of Refugees,

Realizing that the European continent now can be characterized as prone to the threat, which is based on the constant flow of migrants from the countries of Syria, Eritrea, Afghanistan,

Stressing that migrants and asylum-seekers must be engaged in the economic and social spheres of the countries they are residing at the moment of seeking,

Being convinced that tolerance and non-discrimination should be promoted and the myths about migrants in the European countries must be dispelled,

Deeply regretting the countries' losses, which took place in the recent years, while refugees were seeking in search of safe places to live in,

- 1. Calls for organization and funding of compulsory socialization programs by creating compulsory language courses;
- 2. *Requests to* disallow the racist, sexist, xenophobic, antireligious, and other public discrimination in case between refugees and European citizens;
- 3. *Invites* all Member-states to invest in refugee research and rescue operations which are held on the European continent and coastal waters of Europe;
- 4. *Calls* all the Member States for expanding workplaces, livelihoods, education centers and educational institutions of further education for refugees to maintain the literacy rate hence their professional qualification, thus limiting street beggary;
- 5. Calls upon careful consideration of the amount of unemployment benefits to avoid reliance on social aid as the sole financial source and increase motivation for refugees to be employed;

6. *Encourages* providing help to most affected refugee and asylum-seekers receiving countries by transferring of financial support and NGO involvement in social related assistance issues.
