## **Resolution 2**

## adopted by the First General Assembly Committee on 10 November 2017

The General Assembly

*Reaffirming* the importance of national sovereignty and territorial integrity of each state as stated in the United Nations Charter,

*Keeping in mind* that some countries may regard foreign military bases as a violation of national sovereignty,

*Deeply concerned* that foreign military bases encourages militarism, arms race and aggressive actions,

Acknowledging that military bases contribute to achieving international stability, peace and protecting civilian populations,

- 1. *Calls upon* limiting the amount and types of weapons allowed in foreign military bases;
- 2. *Calls for* abolishing the immunity of soldiers outside the Foreign Military Bases so as that they will abide by the host countries' law;
- 3. *Strongly urges* all the sending nations to be responsible for any environmental damage caused in process of installation or operation of a base;
- 4. *Requests* forbidding the use and storage of radioactive substances in foreign military bases;
- 5. *Condemns* imprisonment and torture being held in foreign military bases
- 6. *Suggests* that the distribution of military facilities should correspond with the needs of a host country and situation in a region;
- 7. *Proposes* to create a set of rules and stands that will serve as a guarantee for protecting economic interests of host states;
  - 8. *Decides* to remain actively seized of the matter.
