**Adopted by the Security Council at its 2nd meeting
on October 23, 2020**

The Security Council,

Accepting the fact that the situation in the Jammu and Kashmir region requires a clear solution,

Noting with the regret that Jammu and Kashmir conflict is considered as one of the oldest in the world,

Deeply concerned about the tension in the region and calling on peaceful and diplomatic measures of settlement,

1. Condemns any terroristic acts in this region and asks the UN to provide the region with UN Peacekeeping forces to prevent escalation of the conflict;
2. Requests Security Council to ensure and create favorable environment for transparent negotiations between the nations with accordance to the rights of all the parties of the conflict;
3. Urges India to regain special status of Jammu and Kashmir in order to give the peoples of this regions the ability to realize they rights to self-determination;
4. Calls on the parties of the conflict to guarantee equal rights regardless of origins or religious beliefs of people.
