**Adopted by the Security Council at its 2nd meeting
on October 23, 2020**

The Security Council,

Expressing concern about the duration of the Israeli-Palestinian conflict, and about the probability of its escalation at any time;

Having considered the previous resolutions of Security Council 2334 and 478,

Expressing alarm that violence in the region puts peace, stability and certainty in the future under threat,

Recognizing the necessity of putting more attention of international community to the tensions in the region in the view of long-lasting terrorism activity,

Strongly condemning the growing number of victims of this conflict,

Emphasizing the importance of promotion and protection of human rights,

Expressing the concern over the growing number of refugees,

1. Recommends to provide the Palestinian refugees the right of return and provide the compensation from open humanitarian funds to the refugees not willing or not allowed to return to the State of Palestine;
2. Calls upon to give the State of Palestine the right of providing with civil, municipal, infrastructural and security matters in the West Bank, Gaza Strip and transitions between them, thus giving to Palestinian people the right of control of their own territory, with the security of the State of Israel military forces for the period of 1 year;
3. Asks the State of Palestine to guarantee the cease of military actions from its territories in case The State is provided with guarantees that the State of Israel gives it the right to build the sovereign state;
4. Calls the state of Palestine and the state of Israel for a new negotiation on the topic of creation of the state of Palestine with a supervision of China, France, Russian Federation, United Kingdom and the USA, where the question of the territorial borders of the State of Palestine should be discussed.
